Term Two Reporting:

Communicating Student Learning & (Report Cards)

Jan-March, 2019

1) Report Cards will be going home on **March 15** for students in Div. 1, 5, 6, 11, 12, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18 19. 20.

2) **Student Portfolio Pilot Project Classes:** For those Divisions who are involved in the Student Reporting Pilot Project (Div. 2, 3, 4, 7, 8, 9 10 & 13), teachers will be posting information through the portal about student learning—**this term please access information about your child’s learning online. There will be no written report going home.** For term two, teachers will be posting points of progress in three more subject areas. In addition, classroom teachers will be organizing conferences to communicate with you regarding your child’s learning and their behavior & engagement.

For all classes: There is one early dismissal day for Conferences on March 14th (12:00 Dismissal).

However, there is some flexibility in conference times—**so please watch for a notice/letter from your child’s teacher regarding your child’s conference schedule this term.**

Student Portfolio Pilot Project Classes:

By the end of April, teachers will be posting points of progress in three more subject areas as well as #2 Self Reflection on a Core Competency (unless it’s been posted earlier).

Report Cards will go home on June 27th

For Student Reporting Pilot Project classes (Div. 2, 3, 4, 7, 8, 9 10 & 13)

Teachers **will also provide a Written report on June 27th** which will include a summary of progress in **all the subject areas based on the competency scales**, as well as information about engagement and behaviour. In addition, students will have completed their final Self Reflection on a Core Competency.



Cold and Flu Season
