Additionally, there has been an increase in lunches being dropped off at the office, including various fast-food items. It is very important that students arrive at school with a healthy lunch at the beginning of the day. This helps minimize disruptions and ensures your child is prepared for a successful school day.



NO ELECTRIC SCOOTERS AT SCHOOL

We are asking for your support in ensuring that students do NOT bring e-scooters to school. We have seen an increase in safety concerns involving e-scooters on and around school property, including near-miss accidents during busy pick-up and drop-off times. To help keep all students safe, we need to reduce the presence of high-speed devices in these crowded areas.

In addition, local city bylaws restrict the use of motorized scooters for children, particularly in pedestrian zones and areas with heavy foot traffic—conditions that apply to our school grounds. We kindly ask families to help their children choose safe, permitted ways to travel to and from school.

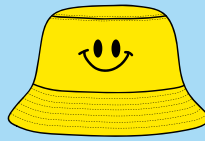

Mr. Angman will be running Math Club on Fridays at Lunch in the Gym for grades 4-7

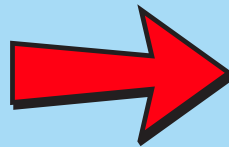
