Traffic Safety and Walking to School



Student safety is the top priority at Ferris. We know that drop-off and pick-up at Ferris can be quite challenging due to the volume of vehicle and pedestrian traffic. We continue to grow and our school will soon be over 600 students. The most important way for families to help reduce congestion in the neighbourhood and increase safety is to walk to school whenever possible. Walking has added health and environmental benefits as well. Studies show that some of the lowest air quality in urban areas is around schools during drop-off and pick-up times. We know that many of our families are unable to walk to school due to mobility or other factors. The more students walk to school, the easier it is to accommodate these families.

Here are some important traffic reminders:

- **Student Drop Off:** Sunnymede Cr. has a long no stopping zone in front of the school. Parents dropping off students need to park outside of the no stopping zone. Please do not drop off students or pick them up in the no stopping zone.
- **Parking Lot:** The parking lot is reserved for staff. Any parents accessing the lot need to have permission from the school.
- **Drop-Off Loop:** The drop-off loop is closed from 8:30 9:00 am and 2:30 3:00 pm. The loop has been closed in the afternoon for several years. We began closing it in the morning as a COVID measure, however, it was soon realized that pedestrians were much safer with it closed at this time. For this reason, we will continue with these closure times.
