

#### **READING BUDDIES AT FERRIS**

Reading Buddies is an initiative that supports children who are beginning readers and helps to build their confidence and improve their skills. Children are paired with an older student volunteer and spend time reading together in a supportive environment. This program runs for six weeks with buddies getting together twice a week. Little Buddies have the opportunity to engage with a Big Buddy, build relationships, and develop literacy skills.







## WHEN YOUR CHILD SHOULD STAY HOME?



As busy parents it is not always easy to tell when you should keep your child home from school and its not always convenient. Below are the guidelines that we use to determine when your child should stay home.

- If your child has tested positive for Covid-19
- If your child has a fever (99.5F or 37.5C or above)
- If your child has pink eye or an undiagnosed rash
- If your child has vomited or had diarrhea in the last 48 hours
- If your child has a cough, runny nose and or sore throat
- If your child seems overtired or just not their usual self.
- If your child is not well enough to go outside for recess or too tired to participate in class, this is a good indication that they should stay home

Keeping your child at home when they are sick will speed up thier recovery and help to keep our school a healthy place.
