For students who placed orders for Ferris Wear, your items will be sent home via your classroom teacher during the first week of June.

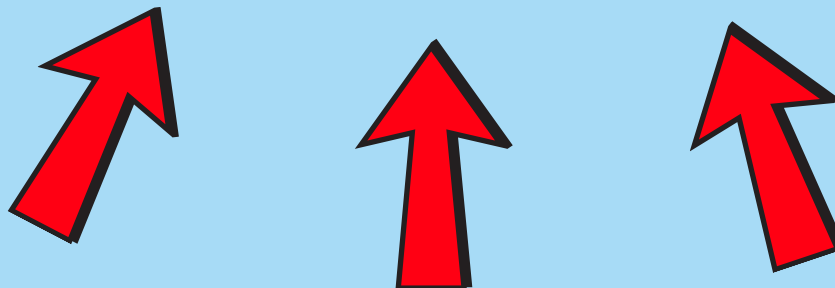

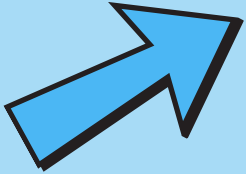


SEPTEMBER 2025 - NOTICE OF LATE RETURN

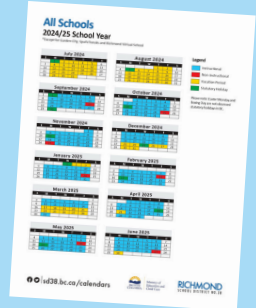
We have started planning for the September 2025/2026 school year.

We understand families have also started planning family vacations and we want to remind families that the district policy states a student cannot miss more than 20 instructional days during the year.

This however, **does not** apply for the start of the September 2025/2026 school year.



Students who are not in school by the end of day on **Friday, September 12th, 2025, will be withdrawn.**



If a family knows that they are going to return to school after Tuesday September 2nd, they can fill out a Notice of Late Return, but they must return on or before September 12th.

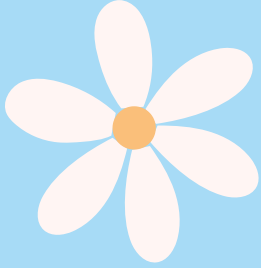
WHEN YOUR CHILD SHOULD STAY HOME?

As busy parents it is not always easy to tell when you should keep your child home from school and its not always convenient. Below are the guidelines that we use to determine when your child should stay home.

- If your child has tested positive for Covid-19
- If your child has a fever (99.5F or 37.5C or above)
- If your child has pink eye or an undiagnosed rash
- If your child has vomited or had diarrhea in the last 48 hours
- If your child has a cough, runny nose and or sore throat
- If your child seems overtired or just not their usual self.
- If your child is not well enough to go outside for recess or too tired to participate in class, this is a good indication that they should stay home

Keeping your child at home when they are sick will speed up their recovery and help to keep our school a healthy place.

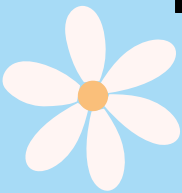
