

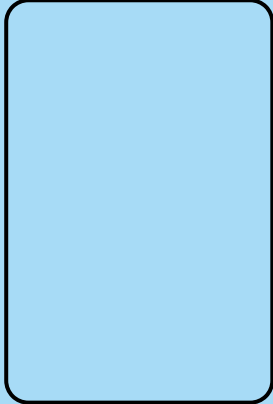

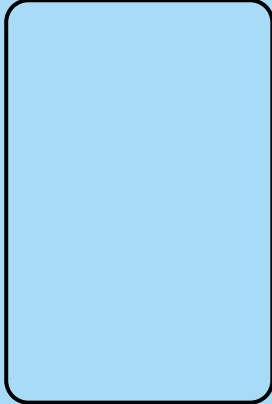

The drill on May 26 will practice a scenario (like an earthquake) where students will need to be picked up from school.

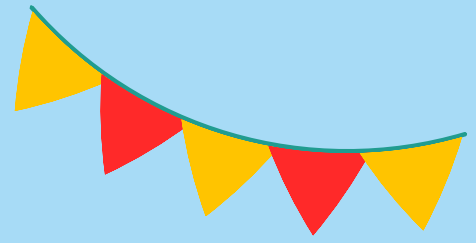
We are looking for parent volunteers who can arrive at the school at approximately 2:00pm, to pick up and take their child(ren) home after the evacuation part of the drill.
